# Validations in SEMDA

All validations are same as for My Rotary

For Email rules at RI, see at end of this document.

# The fundamental for validations should be that all data should be <u>validated at the source</u> = the local membership system (CMS).

These validations are made before Semda tries to send record to RI.

For Members, these validations are made:

-	Date of Birth	must be 10 char. Format YYYY-MM-DD. Age min 15 max 110	
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- Name First must be minimum 2 char and not start with **non-alphabetic** character
- Name Family must be minimum 2 char and not start with **non-alphabetic** character
- Address line 1 must be minimum 2 char and not start with **non-alphabetic** character
- Address line 2 If given, Address line 1 must also be given
- Address line 3 If given, Address line 2 must also be given
- Post Code must be minimum 2 char and not start with **dot, dash** 
  - Postal code is mandatory <u>only for</u> USA and Canada
- City must be minimum 2 char and not start with **non-alphabetic** character
- Country must be minimum 2 char and not start with **non-alphabetic** character
- State If Country is United States, Canada and India, State is mandatory (TX, IL CA ...)
- Country codes shall be according to NATO 2-character table
- Gender, must be *Male* or *Female* **ONLY** (Eventually DNI will be valid)
- Member Type, must be *Member* or *Honorary member* **ONLY**
- If Add-On for Rotaract, *Rotaractor* and *Honorary Rotaractor* is also valid
   Email, must have an @ and at least one dot after the @. Blank or minimum 5 char. may not contain an address already used in the complete database
- All phones, **BOTH** Country Code and Phone number must exist or **NONE** of them Country codes shall be according to NATO table.
- Classification Honorary members may not have classification
- Magazine Will be removed in new Semda

#### Old values that will be removed in new Semda

- Address line 1 must be minimum 2 char and not start with **non-alphabetic** character
- Address line 2 If given, Address line 1 must also be given \_
- Address line 3 If given, Address line 2 must also be given
- Can be blank but not start with **non-alphabetic** character. Max 20 char Postcode
- must be minimum 2 char and not start with **non-alphabetic** character City
- must be minimum 2 char and not start with **non-alphabetic** character Country shall be according to NATO table
- Country codes -
- must be minimum 2 char and not start with **non-alphabetic** character Meet place
- Meet day Mon, Tues, Wed, Thurs, Fri, Sat, Sun -
- Meet time 0000 - 2359
- Club Email may not contain an address already used in the complete database. A common error is that clubs set email address to a member

Clubs can have a postal address as well. Address above is the Meeting address

- OfficeAddress line 1 must be minimum 2 char and not start with **non-alphabetic** character
- OfficeAddress line 2 If given, Address line 1 must also be given
- OfficeAddress line 3 If given, Address line 2 must also be given -
- OfficePost Code must be minimum 2 char and not start with **dot**, **dash**
- OfficeCitv Can be blank but not start with non-alphabetic character. Max 20 char
- OfficeLocation must be minimum 2 char and not start with **non-alphabetic** character Location is a name of the address

For Officers, these validations are made:

- Honorary member cannot be any Officer
- Start date and End date must be within the Rotary years

A non-alphabetic character means a character lower than "A" in the ASCII table (Hex 41). This will take care of dot, dash, and other bad characters.

Invalid characters in text fields are: !#\$%&/()\*+,-.:;<>=?@[]{}\\_|~"

Invalid characters in email fields are: !#

#### **About Sponsors**

- When the Sponsoring Member ID is provided, a relationship of New Member -Sponsored by and New Member Sponsor is created.
- A Sponsoring Member should only be added on the Membership type of Member
- Honorary members cannot have Sponsors
- Honorary members cannot be a Sponsor to a member
- The Sponsoring MemberID needs to be an Active member in the same Club of the new member at the time of admission date of the new member
- Individual sponsorship is only available for club type: "Rotary Club". -

## Some validation from RI

Date format in Semda is yyyy-mm-dd, Semda convert it to mm/dd/yyyy when sending to RI

For those who are older than 100 years, we will update the birth date via email for you.
FirstName	<ul> <li>Required. The current first name as it exists in the database. It's to double-check that we are changing the right record. MemberID shall not be used as the only record ID item.</li> <li>Latin Characters (alphabet)</li> <li>Diacritics</li> <li>Only these special characters . – ' " and space</li> </ul>
Gender	May be skipped (if not updating) but it cannot be an empty string. Valid values: Male, Female, DNI
LastName	<ul> <li>Required. The current last name that exists in the database. It's to double-check that we are changing the right record. MemberID shall not be used as the sole ID item if we are going to change person's name.</li> <li>Latin Characters (alphabet)</li> <li>Diacritics</li> <li>Only these special characters . – ' " and space</li> </ul>
MiddleName	<ul> <li>Field may be blank or NULL. Maximum length is 30 characters</li> <li>Latin Characters (alphabet)</li> <li>Diacritics</li> <li>Only these special characters . – ' " and space</li> </ul>
Prefix(Title)	Field may be blank or NULL Field is free format but should conform to the widely accepted titles such as Mr., Mrs., Ms., Dr., Capt., Lt., Rev., Gen., Prof., etc. including foreign titles. Prefix is included in all Rotary mailings in front of the name. Maximum length is 12 characters (dependency on legacy applications)
Email Addresses	Required Valid E-mail address having two parts joined with an at-sign (@). Valid E-mail address does not include spaces.

#### Addresses

Field	Description / Validation
AddressLine1	Address Line 1 cannot start with a space ( ), dash , dot (.) This field may not be blank or NULL
	This field has to be more than 1 character, cannot start with space (), dash (-) or dot (.) Maximum field length is 40 characters
AddressLine2	Address Line 2 cannot start with a space ( ), dash , dot (.) This field may be blank or NULL - for details on blank vs. NULL values, see #5 at FAQ Maximum field length is 40 characters
AddressLine3	Address Line 3 cannot start with a space ( ), dash , dot (.) This field may be blank or NULL Maximum field length is 40 characters If AddressLine2 is empty, AddressLine3 must be empty, too. Blank data in the middle creates problems when labels are created.
AddressType	This field may not be blank or NULL Valid values are: Home or Business Record ID (member) must be an owner of this address in RI database.
City	This field may not be blank or NULL Maximum length is 40 characters
Country	This field may not be blank or NULL Refer to RI Country admin service for country names used by RI corporate database ( <u>RI Countries</u> ).
IsPrimary	boolean: true, false (but not True, False)
PostalCode	If the country is United States and territories (such as Guam, Micronesia, Puerto Rico, US Virgin Islands, American Samoa,
	Marshall Islands, Northern Mariana Islands, Palau), and Canada – then this field may not be blank or NULL. Maximum length is 20 characters

State	If the country is United States and Canada and India – then this field may not be blank or NULL. Refer to US Post Office or Canadian Post Office 2-digit abbreviation for proper entry. U.S Territories cannot use the State field since they are listed as separate countries. 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### Email rules at RI database.

A email address must be unique in the COMPLETELY database in Rotary International.

This means that same address cannot exist on a member and a club

It is common that a member begins his work as secretary in a club, he add his email address as the club email address. **This is not allowed.** 

A solution to this problem is that Rotary in a country provide all clubs with an email account for the club.

In Sweden for example, we have addresses like <a href="mailto:clubname@rotary.se">clubname@rotary.se</a>
